- Room 7, 8 & 9 are up and running in their revamped classroom, teachers are quite surprised by the sound quality, being not so loud. All just getting to grips with where things are and how the three classes work together
- Angel Newall new entrants teacher new room 23, room 24 is the utilities room versatile room for other activities such as Math/Music
- We are hoping by mid-September things will get back to normal with fencing down by then too etc...
- School community involvement in the strategic plan for next year. A few open evenings to make suggestions for strategic structure of school, give parents/caregivers the opportunity to give feedback for the strategic plan in time for next year. More information coming soon.

- The school is in a very strong financial position in case there is the need for teacher aids, learning support etc.... as our role increases
- The Board represents the community making sure they are doing the best they can for the school, that the teachers are doing the best they can for the school and the Board recognise this and discusses these items to make decisions on what the school needs for example: new buildings/upgrades
- Optimistic that things will be up and running back to normal by mid-September, music room will be back to normal as will library.
- Room 23 hoping to become a more fixed building. MoE (Ministry of Education) have recognised that our role
 is increasing and will provide funding for future classroom/teacher support however it could take a year or so
- The Board is not just a dictatorship but they do invite teachers/parents/community to give feedback into what else they can do to provide a better way for the school.
- The more we can work together as a community the better our school can become
- Apologies but 3 months of pain for a long term gain for the new facilities
- Will be upgrading the hall next term
- ERO are here end of October, we are on a 4 5 year cycle, this takes a week for ERO to view the school policies and procedures then write a report which is available to the public about how the school runs
- We will be opening the upgraded buildings officially, this will happen once they are all up and running with a traditional opening.
