There has been discussion on getting heating/cooling solutions in the class rooms and this will be cost dependant.

- New timetable moving the first session making it longer, then lunch went back 15mins and afternoon slightly shorter. But to date seems to be working well with the learning factor.
- Great start to the year. Integrating a few new members of staff that have settled in well.
- Role is sitting at 537 (last year 518) but we wont get quite as high as last year
- No national standards, we are in limbo as to where to go with this. Ian's thoughts are to keep the information ticking over as the standards have been to date this just wont be "National Standard" based when you receive the reports. There will not be a lot of difference.
- PB4L Positive behaviour for Learning PD program for teachers. Very much like the care program building positive behaviours through our teaching and community. Mistry funded project.
- Just confirmed a few teacher only days throughout the year. Friday 13 April, coaching day September 21 or 24
- Finishing day for school will be Wednesday 19 December.
- The law has been changed around restraint and we are fortunate to have MoE PD for our staff. (That is seen as restraining or holding the students against will.) There is training for the staff to do and this will be covered with one of the teacher only day.
- For school picnic we do have signs that relate to the teams and these will be laid out tomorrow for the picnic and the families can go to these areas if they would like to, teachers will be in these areas.

Welcome John Winters - Life Walk Chaplin

The reason for Chaplin is a great source for the school as children who have any issues or need someone to talk to can do so with John. It is important for the children to have someone to turn to who they can trust outside their classroom. Everything is confidential. If there is any form of abuse etc... this will be reported to Ian. John will report quarterly to the board on what the issues may be about. Diary and appointments book will go round the school for the children to book in. John starts Monday week. There will be a confidential way for transporting the diary around the school.

Usually held last Thursday of every month and Mark has been re-elected on the board as Chairperson.

- ERO came in last year and we have had a glowing reference for the school. Our next review will be 4 -5 years which is a huge credit to lan/staff and the school.
- The board looked at the policies and procedures to make things easier for the community. We have joined school docs for this, so all policies and procedures will be found here and are also in different languages.
- Financially we are in a good place. We will be keeping the portable classrooms on for the year
- We are not doing any major structural changes this year so we can have a fairly smooth year. There may be some cosmetic changes which will be less intrusive on the school and be done on weekends or holidays.
- Our big project this year is 'Raise the Roof' the board will put some money into this, we have hired someone who works with charities to help us get more funding and hoping that the PTA helps too. If these funds come through then the money can be disbursed to other projects such as the hall.
- School donations have not been abolished these are for the school that help with the educational aspect of the school. It is a donation you should not feel pressured to pay this.
