Tau Hou hari 新年快乐, Last month, Mrs Leader, Mrs Lowden and I were very fortunate to attend a conference on the theme of 'Future Schools'. Our goal was to participate in learning with other educators from New Zealand and Australia, about trends, research and developments in schooling.

A number of key messages were communicated during the conference.

- How effective education systems are moving away from a production-line, one-size-fits all standardised approach to learning, towards a culture which recognises individuality and promotes creativity.
- The importance of focusing on learner wellbeing and students' sense of belonging at school during their primary years, and its connection to ensuring good mental health as an adult.

We are currently in a time of major global reform in education, and we are likely to see a number of major changes in how schools operate, and meet the needs of our local, national and global societies. A number of the speakers who presented at the conference are well-known experts in the field of educational change, with Sir Ken Robinson likely to be one you may have heard of. If you get the opportunity, take some time to find a 2018 video on YouTube in which he is speaking about "Reimagine Learning that Can Change the World".
