CHOOL'S ON LINE SHOP:

After a successful trial period, Kindo will be fully introduced into the school next year. Your families Kindo account can be used to book, pay and provide permissions. No cash, no paper, no hassle.

Setting up an account is very quick! Visit **www.mykindo.co.nz** and click 'create account'. Use <u>caregiver or parent</u> details for the **Account Holder** and <u>student details</u> for **Member.** Links are also available on the school website.

To pay through Kindo, you can pay —as-you-go, or add funds to your account in advance. Bank transfer (via internet banking or POLi) are free and there is a small charge for credit/debit card. Kindo supports American Express, Mastercard, Visa and Union Pay.
